



Ecology of a Pushback

This project confronts **structural racism and border violence in Europe** through political art, public mobilisation, and grassroots organising. Touring immersive installations and audiovisual works across key cities, it exposes the **human consequences of racialised border policies**. Workshops and public discussions led by people on the move, activists, and experts foster **critical awareness and dialogue**. Coordinated street actions, community forums, and digital campaigns mobilise collective resistance against deportations and racial profiling. By engaging people in **awareness activities** and activating in concrete actions, the **project strengthens anti-racist networks** and builds sustained, transnational grassroots **movements for migration justice**.
